Being safe

by

Thinking

- Think before you do something

Checking

- See if it's safe to walk /climb on
(ask someone if you are not sure)

Looking

- Make sure its not broken before using it.

Giant Rainbow Pipes & Steering Wheels

No waving the pipes in anyone's face

No hitting anyone with the pipes or steering wheels

No banging the pipes or steering wheels on the ground



Do not jump or step on the pipes or steering wheels

Have fun talking to each other through the pipes!

Put away in the red box





Quick reminders



Broken boxes get crushed first, then put into **cow bins ONLY**

No cardboard is to be put into the round bins

Put all fabric away in the box at the end of play

Do not smash the boxes

No jumping on the boxes.

Do not swirl the fabric around

No throwing



No boxes when it's raining



No wrapping around the neck

Tidy pile under the shelter afterwards

Make sure the lid of the cow bin can close (if not, adults should use the cow bins in the service yard).

If its raining, please do not take out the fabrics

No ripping the boxes into pieces

Quick reminders

Stack no higher than your waist

No throwing

Must be put away near the pole

No pulling tyres apart

Anything sharp or broken - let an adult know straight away

Small tyres



No throwing

Not higher than waist

No jumping like a trampoline

Can jump off, but not higher than knees

No joining of two crates with rope



Must put cardboard in first when dragging the crates with ropes

Large tyres - rules of use

You must be able to see out of the tyres

Stack to shoulders only

Do not roll fast

Tyres can be scratchy and heavy - handle with care



Put away next to small tyres

Two children to lift a big tyre

Roll tyres to move

Look before rolling

Be prepared for your hands to get a little mucky!

Report anything sharp to an adult straight away

Scooters - rules of use

Go round in clockwise direction.



You are not racing.

Take your time.

Go around the cones.
Don't cut corners.

Pass the scooters to next person.



Look forward.

Have fun.

Don't run across the court.

Stay on the football court.

If the scooter is broken, report it to an adult.



Be kind to each other and share items

No throwing

No material, boxes or cushions when it is raining

No kicking balls in the playground



Tyres and crates in tidy piles near the pole

No swinging scooter boards

Keep the playground tidy

Everyone helps to tidy up.

Listen to each other

Playground Rules:

Who is going to be getting the resources out?

Everybody has to tidy up at the end of play times.

When the whistle goes, look around and help each other to put everything away.

Even if you have not played with something, you need to help tidy up.

Who is going to be tidying them away?

If we're not listening to adults, then we won't be able to play with the resources.

Too many disputes means they'll be taken away.
