Stay & Play Sessions Term Terms and Conditions

- 1.Stay & Play will run from:
- 3.30pm 4.30pm £6.50 Monday Friday. 3:30pm – 5:45pm (Monday – Thursday) 3.30pm – 5:00pm (Friday) - £13.00
- 2. To purchase a session, all school debts must be cleared in full. This includes money owing for Breakfast Club, school dinners, previous Extended Day Care and Stay & Play Session.
- 3. Stay & Play sessions are available to purchase from 10.07.2024 19.07.2024 and any spaces will be available from 03.09.2024. The fee of £6.50 per session is non-refundable. The allocation of clubs will be made on a first come first served basis, upon receipt of payment.
- 4. This is a 'contract' and choices of sessions cannot be changed during the term.
- 5. Parents will be charged in full for each booking regardless of any early collection or absences for their child. (Children should not be collect before 4:30pm, unless an arrangement has been made with the school.)
- 6. Parents are expected to telephone the school, before 4pm, if they are unable to collect their child and give a name and information for any additional adult (not on the collection list) who will collect their child.
- 7. Parents are expected to agree to any emergency medical care needed. Every effort will be made to contact parents if this situation arises.
- 8. A child's place <u>will be withdrawn</u> if they do not follow our Behaviour Policy and our Sebright Standards.
- 9. The school monitors attendance and punctuality. A child's place will be at risk if they have regular non-attendance and/or their parent has persistent lateness.
- 10. Parents will be charged a lateness fine of £5 per 5 minutes. If this runs into the next 5 minutes, an additional £5 will be charged. You will be charged from 4:35pm or 5:45pm. If parents/carers are persistently late collecting the provision will be withdrawn.
- 11. The school will make a referral to Social Services after 6:00pm if no contact can be made with parent/carer.
- 12. Filming and photographs of children may be taken and we will adhere to the Photo Permission given to the School by parent/carer.
