Dear Parents & Carers of Y6 Children

As you will know, SATS takes place for Y6 the week beginning Monday 9th May.

Across the Blossom Federation, we have been working hard with the children and they are more than ready to show their very best.

Whilst these tests are super important, it is only a few tests! They do not assess how amazing and special and individual your children are. It is only a snapshot of a part of them. We are fortunate to have a wonderful set of Y6 cohorts and I know the entire team are especially proud of them.

I do want us to demonstrate the very best we can do and showcase all that the children have learned throughout their primary education. We have been planning and organising for SATS for some time. This has included thinking about the groups for administration, which adults we are going to use and that all the staff are trained to administer the process as per the guidelines. We have met with all staff to go through all the information they need. Will Emms (Chair of Governors), plus the Chairs of the Local School Committees, Jatin Shamji (Federation Business Manager) and I will be present in each school throughout the week to oversee the process and to ensure the security of the tests.

The timetable for each school is as follows:

KS2 SATs Dates 2022 – SATs Week 2022

- **Monday May 9th 2022:** Spelling, punctuation and grammar (Grammar/Punctuation Test) – 45 minutes
- **Monday May 9th 2022:** Spelling, punctuation and grammar (Spelling Test) – 20 minutes
- **Tuesday May 10th 2022:** Reading Test – 60 minutes
- **Wednesday May 11th 2022:** Maths Paper 1 (Arithmetic) – 30 minutes
- **Wednesday May 11th 2022:** Maths Paper 2 (Reasoning) – 40 minutes
- **Thursday May 12th 2022:** Maths Paper 3 (Reasoning) – 40 minutes

More information will come to you from each individual school as we near SATS week, but just a plea from me. It is important that the children get lots of rest, go to bed early and are ready for the special SATS breakfasts we are planning for each morning. We want the children to be in school and on time and ready for action, otherwise I will be popping round to get them!

Thank you for your support as always and for providing such a great bunch of Y6's.
